START OF SPRING LOAD RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 349.16, Wood County Highway season weight restrictions will become effective at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, March 10, 2025 south of STH 73 and at 7:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 11, 2025 north of STH 73.

All information may be viewed on the Wood County website including a list of county roads that are not posted: <https://www.woodcountywi.gov/>

All county road restrictions (lettered roads) shall be posted for 6 tons maximum per single axle and 10 tons maximum per tandem axle group.

Highway maintenance vehicles, school buses, emergency vehicles are exempt from the load restrictions.

Propane haulers, fuel oil haulers, and well drillers should contact the Highway Department in case of an emergency for a special permit.

Bulk milk trucks, waste disposal, and sewage disposal may apply for a special hauling permit which exempts them from the load restrictions. The issued permit shall define the designated route to be utilized.

This notice does not include town roads. Townships will need to be contacted directly for the status of their weight restrictions. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the Highway Department office at 715-421-8875.
