INTRODUCTION

The City of Nekoosa, Wood County, began developing its first Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (C.O.R.P.) in the fall of 2016. A public participation strategy was identified early in the planning process to incorporate an accurate representation of resident opinion into the plan. A community survey of all Nekoosa residents was one means of collecting public input. Surveys were mailed out to each household along with the Nekoosa Newsletter in April 2017. Over 200 residents completed and returned the survey by the May 2017 deadline. The survey gathered information on preferred outdoor recreation amenities, park usage, and attitudes towards the development and enhancement of outdoor recreation opportunities in the community.

This report summarizes the needs, desires and attitudes of Nekoosa residents in regards to parks and outdoor recreation in their community. The report presents numeric tabulation and graphic representation of the questions and answers in the community survey. The input collected through this survey will be used by the C.O.R.P. Planning Committee to develop goals, objectives and recommendations for the plan.



Question 1: Have you or members of your household visited any Nekoosa parks during the past year?

- 86% of respondents answered yes
- > 14% of respondents answered no



Question 2: Approximately how often did you or members of your household visit Nekoosa parks over the past year?

- > 52% of respondents answered 0 to 5 visits
- > 24.5% of respondents answered 6 to 10 visits
- > 8.5% of respondents answered 11 to 19 visits
- > 15% of respondents answered 20 or more visits



Question 3: Overall, how would you rate the condition of all Nekoosa parks visited?

- > 10.5% of respondents said excellent
- 71% of respondents said good
- > 17% of respondents said fair
- > 1.5% of respondents said poor



Question 4: How important are parks and outdoor recreation opportunities to the overall quality of life in Nekoosa?

- > 70.5% of respondents said very important
- > 28% of respondents said somewhat important
- > 1.5% of respondents said not important



Question 5: Do you think the City of Nekoosa should develop more parks and trails?



64% of respondents answered yes
36% of respondents answered no.

Question 6: Do you think that Nekoosa should offer recreation programs and services?

- > 81% of respondents answered yes
- > 19% of respondents answered no

Question 9: Additional comments or suggestions?

- You people are to be commended Well done!
- Our environment around here is a blessing!

- The largest playground is by the river, however, this park is not as nice as the one by the library. The park by the river often has standing water/sloppy areas; no shady areas near the playground, and too much mess from the geese!! I would move that playground up to where the pool was.
- Clean up the space by the cemetery, encourage businesses to keep their properties well kept & sidewalks weed free, keep the city building lawn green & weed free, clean up the wet lands across from the city building (Safety Center). Unfortunately the way Nekoosa presents itself no one drives through town and thinks WOW I'd really like to live here. I've seen worse small towns but I've seen a lot better ones too.
- I feel that the City of Nekoosa needs to put our money back in the outlay accounts so there is funds for the equipment needed, after you have a budget that plans for the city needs then save money for parks & toys.

- > It would be beneficial to have the biking path continue along the river by Point Basse down Hwy A area for safety.
