OUTDOOR RECREATION UPDATE

For Immediate Release:

- Wood County is **CLOSING** all Snowmobile Trails effective Wednesday, February 11, 2026, due to deteriorating conditions.
- Powers Bluff ski and tube hills are **OPEN** this weekend and the hills are in **GOOD** shape. Presales of tow tickets will be available online on Wednesday and Thursday. The multi-use trail is **OPEN** for cross country skiing, snowshoeing, & biking. Current trail conditions for the single-track bike trail can be found at Trailbot.com, or on the trailbot app.
- The Nepco Lake County Park multi-use and cross-country ski trails are **OPEN**, but conditions are deteriorating with warmer weather.
- The Richfield 360 County Forest multi-use trails are **OPEN**, but conditions deteriorating as well.
