<u>#2 – Calls for Service</u>: North end Wood County received a total of 70 calls for service, 4 of which were requests to scene deaths. South end Wood County received a total of 29 calls for service, 9 of which were requests to respond to scene deaths. I received a total of 8 calls requesting follow-up information or requesting copies of reports.

<u>#4 – Falls:</u> In October, we had one case where a 78-year-old fell while standing and fractured his femur. Sadly, he succumbed to this injury a short time later.

#6 – Traffic Fatalities: We responded to 1 traffic fatality involving a semi-truck that rolled in a ditch after leaving the roadway. This incident occurred in the Town of Hiles.

#12 – Pending: While we had no new pending cases in October, we did receive autopsy results for two prior pending cases. One case was ruled natural and the other was accidental due to drug toxicity.

WHEREAS, The Wood County Sheriff's Department puts priority on officer wellness and initiatives to ensure deputies and corrections officers are addressing the demands of law enforcement in a healthy way, and

WHEREAS, The Wood County Sheriff's Department realizes the importance of employee health physically, emotionally, socially, spiritually and financially. The wellness of employees directly affects the success of serving the community. It is imperative to provide quality services to the citizens of Wood County as well as the many stakeholders impacted by the Wood County Sheriff's Department. It is our goal to take an active role toward improving the resources available to employees, and

WHEREAS, the Wood County Sheriff's Department budget is restricted in nature and would be compensated \$32,020 to implement an expanded Department-wide employee wellness initiative through December 2025, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, to amend the Wood County Sheriff Administration (52110) Budget for 2024 to add \$32,020 of unanticipated revenue from the Opioid Settlement Funding in the revenue account (48900) known as Sheriff Dept. Misc Revenue.

For the month of October, the total number of prohibited items prevented from entering the Courthouse are:

The miscellaneous items that were located were two (2) pairs of scissors, a window punch, pliers, a corkscrew and a holster.

Security Services screened 9,145 people entering the courthouse for the month of October. Security Services had 26 security requests from different departments within the Courthouse for the month. We also served three (3) civil process papers, assisted with one (1) jury trial and fulfilled two (2) warrants for the month.

Security Services handled four (4) complaint in the jail. The complaints were for a harassment complaint, a threats complaint and two (2) Criminal Damage to Property complaints.

Security found and returned a wallet, a backpack and even an iPad, that was located on a road in Wisconsin Rapids. We even assisted a motorist that locked his keys in his car.

During the Month, I utilize part-time employees for 47 hours to fill employee shortage hours. Several shifts ran short due to no part-time employees able to help.

I just want to make a little note here that on October 9th, marked Security Services' 5year anniversary, here at the Wood County Courthouse.
