### **June 2024**

1. Spent a significant amount of time working on the Next Gen 911 transition including participating in the Teams call and making test calls in Dispatch.
2. Worked with our microwave equipment vendor to file the certificates of completion to the Federal Communications Commission for the upgrades that were completed earlier this year.
3. Answered a few questions from the Dispatch Manager regarding the outdoor weather sirens. Went over the operation of the siren controller.
4. Met with the Emergency Management Director and the Dispatch Manager along with Wisconsin Rapids Police Department staff to set up the Emergency Management trailer at the Police Department for use on the 4th of July. Worked with IT and an equipment vendor on some radio equipment issues.
5. Looked into a missed lease payment from a tenant on one of our towers.
6. Corresponded with an equipment manufacturer on some new equipment that was not working correctly and sent back to the factory for repair.
7. Corresponded with a site acquisition agent for a cellular carrier regarding lease modifications to a current lease.

## **June 2024 Activity Report**

**REPORTED TO COMMITTEE: 7/8/2024**

### **1. WARNING & COMMUNICATIONS**

- a. On 06/01/2024 A spill of 600 Gals of Dairy Wastewater occurred in Rudolph at the Dairy State Cheese Wastewater Treatment Plant. The spill was caused by equipment failure which caused the wastewater to spill over the tank and into a ditch where it was contained. Pro Septic was hired by Dairy State Cheese for clean-up.
- b. On 06/04/2024 a manure release was reported to the DNR Hotline. Caller stated that manure was being pumped out of the manure pit/barn and is all over the south side of the property. The reporting party is concerned about the potential impact on water quality. Clean up status is unknown, Warden Josh Litvinoff notified. Update 06/25/2024 - DNR Ag Staff and County Conservation staff working with farmer to assist with BMPs
- c. On 06/09/2024 a spill of approximately 15 gallons of transformer oil was reported in the Village of Rudolph. The transformer was taken out by a tree due to strong winds in the area at the time. A contractor responded immediately and excavated ditch line.
- d. On 06/24/2024 a unknown substance was reported to be being dumped into the ditch of Trestik Dr at the Maple Grove Cheese factory. Several dead shrubs were spotted as well. DNR was notified of the release. Clean up status unknown. Update 06/25/2024 - DNR Stormwater and Wastewater confirmed the pond in question has been decommissioned. Release is likely rainwater which is pumped out as needed (few times per year). This is not believed to be a concern and file will be closed.

### **2. FEDERAL/STATE FUNDING**

- a. Submitted updated budget for Community Safe Room to FEMA and are awaiting to see if they are going to increase our grant funding due to increased build costs.

### **3. TRAINING**

- a. Director and Program Coordinator took the Command Trailer to the Wisconsin Rapids Police Department for set up and training for their use during the 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebration in the downtown area.
- b. Deputy Director attended a virtual railroad hazards training class on June 19, 2024.
- c. Deputy Director attended a virtual FEMA GO training on June 20, 2024.
- d. Deputy Director attended a virtual FEMA All Hazards Alerts Training class on June 22, 2024.

**4. Emergency Management Planning**

- a. Talked with the Health Department about the Waukesha Parade After Action Report in preparation for updating and exercising on the Family Assistance Center plan.
- b. Talked with Reuben in Maintenance about the cemetery on Port Road. Instead of billing them for upkeep and maintenance that we do, we are going to transfer that line item into our budget for 2025.
- c. Talked with Rapids FD/PD and Marshfield FD/PD about trying to find some grant funding for mobile vehicle barricades for roads. These would be deployed during parades, vendor fairs, and any other even that roads get closed to have pedestrians and vendors in the roadway. This would make for better safety measures for any events.

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### ACTIVITY REPORT

July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024

- Child Support Reimbursement
- Open Records fulfillment
- Attended Central Wisconsin State Fair Pre-Fair operations meeting with Marshfield Fire, Marshfield PD, Marshfield Streets, Wood County Sheriff, Emergency Management and CW Fair Director.
- Had a meeting with members of IT regarding ongoing discussion surrounding a new CAD/RMS/JMS vendor to create questionnaire for departments using system.
- Conducted interviews for Dispatch vacancies. Interviewed 18 individuals, had 16 of them do a 2 hour sit in the following week. Two were offered employment, accepted and will begin July 8<sup>th</sup> and July 15<sup>th</sup>. Three others were given notice that they will be hired in September/October or later depending on training and all seemed agreeable to that timeline.
- Set up the Emergency Management trailer with equipment at the Wisconsin Rapids Police Department in anticipation of the Fourth of July celebration and staffing it for the event.
- Had Go Live on Next Gen 911 ESInet. It began very well and quickly slowed. An information transfer issue between Charter Communications, various cell phone providers, Solarus and Intrado resulting in our Center going live using a Hybrid set up for approximately a week and a half. As of June 28<sup>th</sup>, changes were completed by Intrado that resolved the transfer problems and we are fully operational with Next Gen 911. Work continues to tweak screen configurations with the phone vendor, ModuCom.
- Held a meeting with the Wood County Sheriff's Department Office Manager and IT regarding the new CAD/RMS/JMS vendor.
- Met with Chief Eckes at Wisconsin Rapids Fire regarding a recent Water Rescue call. He was confused by the response and we determined it is an issue that needs to be taken up at the next Wood County Fire Chiefs' Association meeting.
- Met with Nelson Systems regarding a new call logger/radio recorder system that will be sought using CIP and/or Department of Military Affairs grant funds.
- Held a meeting with DOT representatives regarding new reporting system for car killed deer/bear on roadways.
- Met with CentralSquare to gather information as a possible replacement CAD/RMS/JMS.

**#2 – Calls for Service:** North end Wood County received a total of 68 calls for service, 2 which were requests to scene deaths. South end Wood County received a total of 20 calls for service, 6 of which were requests to respond to scene deaths. I received a total of 7 calls requesting follow-up information or requesting copies of reports.

**#4 – Falls:** In June, we had 3 cases where falls were related to death in our elderly population. 2 of the cases resulted in fractures of either the hip or femur. One of these falls was a 106-year-old who was just a week shy of her 107<sup>th</sup> birthday. The third case resulted in a head injury sustained from the fall, which ultimately claimed the life of the victim. As noted before, due to multiple underlying comorbidities, the elderly population often doesn't heal from injuries received when they fall.

**#8 – Suicide:** Sadly, we saw a record high in suicide cases. These come in a variety of means/methods when an individual takes their own life. In many of these cases, the individual has underlying mental health issues. In two of our cases, the individuals had recently been diagnosed with serious medical conditions.

**#12 – Pending:** We have 1 case “pending” while we await toxicology reporting. We were able to update our two pending cases from last month. One was ruled as natural based on autopsy reports and the other was ruled accidental due to “multiple drug toxicity.” This determination is based on autopsy and toxicology reporting.
