If this probationary introductory period is extended beyond <u>six (6)</u> months the employee will receive the floating holiday after Management's sign off on successful completion.

Floating holidays may be taken at any time during the year following the standard time off provisions set forth by the Dispatch Manager. The date of the floating holiday will be mutually agreed to between the Dispatch Manager and the employee.

Floating holidays do not carry over from one calendar year to the next.

Remarks:

As you are aware, Marathon County has staffed and is now performing autopsies. They will soon be extending an "invite" to surrounding counties to see if they would be interested in having autopsies performed at their facility.

For me, the drive to UW Madison is the only negative to their facility. The cost alone to begin using Marathon County is a deterrent for me. The cost, per autopsy, would increase from our current \$1,500.00 to \$1,7500.00 or

\$2,500.00 depending on the case. I also like being in the autopsy suite to answer any questions about the case if needed and to also take documentation photographs when needed. Further, with our current pathologists, I can discuss cases that aren't even going to autopsy but only discussing how best to sign a case out.

The responses I got from law enforcement are they wish to stay with UW Madison for autopsies. They like being in the autopsy suite to discuss the case with Dr's Corliss and Kallan and can photograph as needed for their cases. They, like myself, also like the ability to discuss cases on a whim.

After seeing the responses from the Wood County law enforcement agencies and seeing the increase in cost per autopsy, we will continue to utilize UW Madison for Wood County autopsies.

I wish Marathon County the best and I know they will be successful in their endeavor. I have no doubt they will provide a quality service. My decision simply came down to cost per autopsy, how we currently operate and the needs of our law enforcement agencies.

#4 – Falls: We had one elderly female that slipped off a shower stool and fractured her right hip. Sadly, she succumbed to these injuries shortly after admission to the hospital. Her death was attributed to the fall and numerous pre-existing comorbidities.

#15 – Autopsies: We performed one autopsy in the month of June on an 8month-old infant. The case is under investigation by the Coroner's Department and City of Wisconsin Rapids PD. We are awaiting toxicology and final autopsy report.
