On 9/12/2025 we received the list of potential jurors for 2026. We are reviewing these carefully before mailing them. We will be focusing on providing more information on completing these questionnaires electronically. Last year we mailed out 3,196 questionnaires. 1,367 of those were returned electronically, roughly 43%. I'm hoping for a return rate of 60% or higher for this years questionnaires. I will be asking HR to place a post on the Wood County Facebook page again this year that residents should watch for these in the mail. That seemed to work out very well last year. I would encourage all of the board members to share that post if you are able to.

On 9/15/2025 the Branch 4 Audio Visual upgrades along with HVAC upgrades began. We have not had to rearrange courtroom use as the judge had a planned vacation during that time. On September 29th, the Branch 3 upgrades will begin so we will be utilizing the reserve courtroom or another courtroom during that two weeks. We will be having additional signage up for litigants during this time so parties are aware of the appropriate room they should appear in.

On 9/16/2025 Four staff members attended the Dementia training at Riverblock. They found the information extremely interesting and were happy they attended the session. I also received a resignation from Abigail Ashbeck. She will be moving out of the area and is unable to make the extended drive, especially during the winter months. We will miss her greatly but wish her all the best in her new adventures! The request for hire form has been completed and I hope to have that posted soon. Until Abigail's replacement is hired, the remaining 3 court clerks will be helping to cover court in the Branch 3 courtroom.

I am set to present my budget to the Operations Committee meeting on September 24, 2025.

The remainder of the month will be training with the jury clerk on the return of the juror qualification questionnaires.

Child Support – During the month of September, the Corporation Counsel's office participated in six dates for Child Support-related hearings (in custody and hearing days)

Appellate Court Brief– In August, our office prepared and filed an Appellate Brief with the District IV Court of Appeals on behalf of the Wood County Human Services Department. Year to date, our office has handled three appeals with one pending disposition from the Court.

Wood County Library Board Bylaws:

During the month of September, I assisted representatives from the Wood County Library Board with an initial discussion, formulation and review of proposed bylaws. The Wood County Library Board was established and operates by virtue of Wis. Stat. Ch. 43, and the Wood County Board Resolution #7, adopted in 1973. To date, the Library Board has not had formal bylaws adopted and operated pursuant to the authority granted in Wis. Stat. ss. 43.57 and 43.58. Formulating and adopting bylaws will provide valuable framework for Library Board governance (i.e. appointment of Officers and their roles), and also allows for a reconciliation and aggregating the statutory authority and duties the Board has, along with powers conferred to them, for easier reference in the future when needed.

Annual Corporation Counsel/Defense Counsel Forum:

Last month, I attended the 32nd Annual Corporation Counsel/Defense Counsel Forum in Stevens Point, WI. The conference served as a great opportunity to meet and talk with my counterparts from other counties, as well as take part in sessions of relevancy to topics my office regularly works on. Specifically, sessions regarding Public Records/Open Meetings Law, Appellate Court updates of relevancy to Corporation Counsel, zoning and land use updates, and procedural/timing considerations regarding employment-related cases handled by the Equal Rights Division (ERD) were all particularly informative and valuable to take part in.

We continue to have monthly sustainability meetings with representatives from the district attorney's office, the division of community corrections, the state public defender, the criminal justice department, and with our treatment court judge. The conversation centers around all aspects of sustainability but varies from month to month. August's meeting resulted in several recommendations that I have been looking into for the last 30 days. It is worth noting that September's meeting is cancelled due to conflicts in the schedule of the treatment court judge and the criminal justice coordinator. We will meet as scheduled in October.

TAD funding has been announced for 2026, and Wood County has the opportunity to apply for the same amount of federal funding as we did in 2025. I look to receive federal funding in the same areas of my budget as in 2025, and my cash match portion of the grant also should look very similar to 2025. I am

currently working on collecting the necessary supporting documents for the application, and then I will be working on a final budget and a submission of the grant (it is due October 2nd).

Jail Programming (STRONG):

Medication Assisted Treatment Program (MARP):

Current Participants: 30 Year to date participants: 107

Jail Residential Treatment Program (RSAT):

Current Participants: 7
Year to date graduates: 3
Year to date participants: 25

The residential treatment program continues through its second cycle in the new facility. As per usual, we have lost some participants along the way. Some were removed due to behaviors, but just as many left due to moving on from the facility. Some of our treatment pod participants reach their discharge date prior to getting to finish, and others get sent to treatment through probation and parole with little warning (and that has always been the case). The Department of Justice has given us the opportunity to extend our current grant through September of 2026 (originally it was supposed to end October 1st, 2025). They also offered us a 100,000-dollar expansion on the grant to continue the work that we have been doing. Furthermore, they have stated that they will have another contract available once we finish spending the expansion money on this one. All of this leads me to believe that they are committed to continuing to support our jail residential treatment program here in Wood County. In the coming weeks I will create a budget for the expansion, but I expect that the majority of it will be spent to support existing staff, existing contracts with treatment providers and peer support, and medication costs.

A large portion of our jail programming is funded by an Opiate Settlement Fund allotment from DHS. This allotment ran from July 2024-June 2025 and we have finally received our final spend-down amount from our previous contract. We will be utilizing these 142,847 dollars to create a new contract from July of 2026-June of 2027. I have a little over one week to create a budget for this, and I anticipate that it will be used to mostly support existing staff, existing contracts, and to pay for some medication costs for our MARP program.

Other Matters:

Our team participated in another community outreach opportunity, along with Three Bridges Recovery, at the Thursday Farmer's Market here in Wisconsin Rapids on 9/11/2025. We are scheduled to make one more appearance next month. This gives my staff and recovery coaches from Three Bridges Recovery an opportunity to discuss our various programs, harm reduction information, and information about peer support and recovery coaching with individuals from the community.

The County has announced that they are accepting applications for the next round of County Opioid Settlement Dollars. We did receive funding from this source in 2025, and I hope to obtain funding again in 2026 in this area. I have not yet determined which specific programs or areas I would like to apply this funding to.

As this report reflects, I have several opportunities to secure funding for my department's programs right now. I anticipate that the next couple of weeks will mostly be spent completing all of the necessary applications and budget extensions in order to make that a reality.

There was one trial in the last month. ADA Zima obtained a conviction for OWI 5th and Disorderly Conduct as Domestic Abuse in a trial before Judge Jerabek.

Since the last report, the District Attorney attended the Department Head Meeting on August 27, 2025. Additionally, on September 4, 2025, the District Attorney attended a Department of Justice Data Projects Feedback meeting through Microsoft Teams. This meeting was to discuss the current case managing software used statewide and possible changes and revisions being recommended. On September 5, 2025, the District Attorney and ADA Michael Montgomery met with the supervisors in the Department of Human Services Family Services Division to coordinate on CHIPS and Juvenile Justice processes. On September 9, 2025, the District Attorney presented at before this committee int eh budget review process and also attended the Judges' Meeting over the lunch hour. On September 10, 2025, the District Attorney attended the Wood County Mental Health Court Quarterly Meeting. On September 16, 2025, the District Attorney attended the monthly meeting of the Wood Count Board of Supervisors.

Between August 29, 2025 and the filing of this report, there have been 243 charges referred to this office. 159 of those have been reviewed and filed as appropriate. 53 cases are still being reviewed for possible charges. Additionally, this office has created and put in place a Policy and Procedure Manual for the first time.

ADA Michael Montgomery started with the office on August 25, 2025. ADA Lisa Temich started with the office on September 8, 2025. At this point the office has a full staff of Assistant District Attorneys. We did have the loss of Victim Witness Coordinator Alicia Parenteau who had her last day on September 11, 2025. Additionally, Kim Thurber (Legal Assistant) left to take a position with the Public Defender's Office. We have begun interviews and hope to have both positions filled shortly. The District Attorney's Office is also taking applications for the two new ADA positions that will be assigned to Wood County starting October 5, 2025 as part of the new State Budget.
