

MINUTES CRIMINAL JUSTICE TASK FORCE

1. Judge Jerabek called the meeting to order at 12:12 PM.
2. Motion by Ksionek/Stimac to approve the minutes of the March 18, 2026, meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
3. There was no public comment.
4. Criminal Justice Coordinator Ksionek gave a year-to-date vs. 2025 overview of Drug Court. He has been informed that the Medication Assisted Treatment position has another grant that he will be applying for later this year. He will be talking to Probation and Parole about the Drug Court with hopes of increasing the number of participants. All UA's have been moved from the Johnson Hills building to the new Jail.
5. District Attorney Barnett discussed the openings for ADAs in his office as another ADA has put in their resignation and is going to Clark County. He currently has 3 of 7 ADAs with one offer out. Public Defender is also down 50% of their attorneys as well.
6. Under agency roundtable, James Bennett from the State Public Defenders office commented on how terrible the WiFi is in on the 3rd floor and asked if there was anything that could be done to get a different network for attorneys or something. Judge Jerabek echoed that his courtroom is not good for WiFi. Bennett has made inquiries to the Help Desk previously but is looking for more direction on how to rectify the situation. He also shared a recent poll of private attorneys inquiring why they do not take on court appointed cases. Most of the time it comes down to money/mileage but there were other reasons as well.
7. Judge Jerabek adjourned the meeting at 12:32 PM.
